Course Description

This qualification reflects the role of a skilled operator working with civil construction plant, who applies a broad range of skills in a varied work context, using some discretion and judgement and relevant theoretical knowledge. The individual may provide theoretical advice and support a team.

Selection Criteria

- Students must not have fear of confinement
- Students must have the capacity to stand for extended periods of time
- Due to the physical requirements of these units the student must have the ability to perform lifting and manual excavation tasks using a variety of equipment
- Students must be able to get on their knees on the floor and perform CPR on a manikin continuously for a least 2 minutes
